

# CROCHET HAT BY I-AM-CHEN





#### CROCHET MEASUREMENTS

- Circumference before stretching: 20"/51 cm
- Circumference after stretching: 26"/66 cm
- Hat length: 6 ¼"/16 cm, excluding earflaps
- Earflap length: 2 1/2"/6 cm
- Earflap width: 4 3/4"/12 cm

#### MATERIALS

- 50 grams 100% extrafine Merino wool (we recommend 19 micron)
- US size D-3 (3mm) crochet hook
- Tapestry needle (to weave in ends)

#### SKILLS REQUIRED

**NOTE:** American crochet terms are used in this pattern.

- Chain stitch
- Slip stitch
- tr2tog (treble crochet 2 together):
- 1. Yarn over hook twice, insert hook in next stitch.
- 2. Yarn over and pull the yarn through a loop (4 loops on hook).
- 3. Yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, twice, (2 loops on hook).
- Yarn over hook twice, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull the yarn through a loop (5 loops on hook),
- 5. Yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook], twice (3 loops on hook).
- 6. Yarn over and draw through all loops on hook 1 st decreased.

### ABBREVIATIONS

tr = Treble crochet; ch = chain; sl st = slip stitch; beg ch = beginning of chain;

## LET'S GET STARTED!

Rnd 5:

With your crochet hook, ch 6, join with a sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), 11 tr into the ring.

- Rnd 2: Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, 2 tr in each of next tr – 24 sts.
- Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), Rnd 3: tr in base of beg ch, tr in next st, \*2 tr in next st, tr in next st; rep from \* around – 36 sts.
- Rnd 4: Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, tr in each of next 2 sts, \*2 tr in next st, tr in each of next 2 sts; rep from \* around – 48 sts.

	beg ch, tr in each of next 3 sts, *2 tr in next st, tr in each of next 3 sts; rep from * around – 60 sts.
Rnd 6:	Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, tr in each of next 4 sts, *2 tr in next st, tr in each of next 4 sts; rep from * around – 72 sts.
Rnd 7:	Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, tr in each of next 5 sts, *2 tr in next st, tr in each of next 5 sts; rep from * around – 84 sts.
Rnd 8:	Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, tr in each of next 6 sts, *2 tr in next st, tr in each of next 6 sts; rep from * around – 96 sts.
Rnds	

Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of

9-15 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in each st around.

STEP

(work back and forth in rows):

Row 1 (RS):	Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in each of next 19 sts, turn.
Row 2:	Dec Row (WS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr2tog, tr in each of next 15 sts, tr2tog, turn – 18 sts remain.
Row 3:	Dec Row (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr2tog, tr in each st to last 2 sts and AT SAME TIME dec 3 more sts evenly (dec 1 = tr2tog), tr2tog, turn – 13 sts remain.
Row 4:	Dec Row (WS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr2tog, tr in each st to last 2 sts and AT SAME TIME dec 2 more sts evenly (dec 1 = tr2tog), tr2tog, turn – 9 sts remain. Cut yarn and fasten off.
Work second	d earflap same way, keeping 28-st

distance between earflaps. Cut yarn and fasten off.
