## CROCHET HAT

## CROCHET

## MEASUREMENTS

- Circumference before stretching: $20 " / 51 \mathrm{~cm}$
- Circumference after stretching: $26^{\prime \prime} / 66 \mathrm{~cm}$
- Hat length: $61 / 4 " / 16 \mathrm{~cm}$, excluding earflaps
- Earflap length: $21 / 2 " / 6 \mathrm{~cm}$
- Earflap width: $43 / 4 / 1 / 12 \mathrm{~cm}$


## SKILLS REQUIRED

NOTE: American crochet terms are used in this pattern.

- Chain stitch
- Slip stitch
- tr2tog (treble crochet 2 together):

1. Yarn over hook twice, insert hook in next stitch.
2. Yarn over and pull the yarn through a loop (4 loops on hook).
3. Yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, twice, (2 loops on hook).
4. Yarn over hook twice, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull the yarn through a loop (5 loops on hook).
5. Yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook], twice (3 loops on hook).
6. Yarn over and draw through all loops on hook-1 st decreased.

## MATERIALS

- 50 grams 100\% extrafine Merino wool lwe recommend 19 micron)
- US size D-3 ( 3 mm ) crochet hook
- Tapestry needle (to weave in ends)


## ABBREVIATIONS

tr = Treble crochet; $\mathbf{c h}=$ chain; $\mathbf{s l} \mathbf{s t}=$ slip stitch; beg $\mathbf{c h}=$ beginning of chain;

## LET'S GET STARTED!



With your crochet hook, ch 6, join with a sl st in first ch to form a ring.
Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), 11 tr into the ring. Rnd 2: Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, 2 tr in each of next tr - 24 sts.

Rnd 3: Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, tr in next st, *2 tr in next st, tr in next st; rep from * around -36 sts.

Rnd 4: $\quad$ Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, tr in each of next 2 sts, *2 tr in next st, tr in each of next 2 sts; rep from * around - 48 sts.
(work back and forth in rows):
Row 1 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in each of next 19 sts, turn.
Row 2: Dec Row (WS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr2tog, tr in each of next 15 sts, tr2tog, turn - 18 sts remain.

Row 3: Dec Row (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr2tog, tr in each st to last 2 sts and AT SAME TIME dec 3 more sts evenly (dec 1 = tr2tog), tr2tog, turn - 13 sts remain.

Row 4: Dec Row (WS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr2tog, tr in each st to last 2 sts and AT SAME TIME dec 2 more sts evenly (dec $1=$ tr2tog), tr2tog, turn - 9 sts remain. Cut yarn and fasten off.
Work second earflap same way, keeping 28 -st distance between earflaps. Cut yarn and fasten off.

Rnd 5: $\quad \operatorname{Inc}$ Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, tr in each of next 3 sts, *2 tr in next st, tr in each of next 3 sts; rep from * around - 60 sts.
Rnd 6: $\quad$ Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, tr in each of next 4 sts, *2 tr in next st, tr in each of next 4 sts; rep from * around -72 sts.

Rnd 7: $\quad$ Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, tr in each of next 5 sts, *2 tr in next st, tr in each of next 5 sts; rep from * around - 84 sts.

Rnd 8: Inc Rnd (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in base of beg ch, tr in each of next 6 sts, *2 tr in next st, tr in each of next 6 sts; rep from * around - 96 sts.

Rnds
9-15 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in each st around.
