

PYTHON SCARF BY STRATEAS CARLUCCI

Knitted in stocking stitch.





SIZES

Finished Size 30cm x 4.4m

MATERIALS

- 200 grams of any 100% Merino wool yarn, 8 Ply (DK Weight).
- A set of 10.00mm (US 15) knitting needles
- Wool needle for sewing in ends.

SKILLS REQUIRED

- Stocking stich
- Cast on
- Bind off/ Cast off
- Knitwise
- Purlwise

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin, beginning; cm = centimetres; K = knit; P = purl; rep = repeat; st/s = stitch/es; stocking st = knit right side rows, purl wrong side

rows; **tog** = together, **sl** = slip.

knitwise = Insert the right needle into the next stitch on the left needle and place it on the right needle without working it.

purlwise = Insert the right needle (from back to front) into the next stitch on the left needle and place it on the right needle without working it.

LET'S GET STARTED!

Using the **set** of 10.00mm needles, cast on **40** sts.

1st row sl first st knitwise, knit to end.

2nd row sl first st **purlwise**, purl to end.

Repeat 1st and 2nd rows until work measures 4.4m

Finish working on the 2nd (purl) row.



BINDING OFF/ CASTING OFF

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Knit two stitches. Insert the top of the left needle into the first stitch on the right needle. Lift the stitch over the last stitch you knit and over the top of the right needle.

One stitch remains on the right needle. Knit another stitch. Lift that stitch over the stitch you just knitted.

Continue in this way until one loop remains. Cut the yarn, leaving a tail of 10cm and draw the end through the last stitch.



Sew/weave in the starting and finishing threads which will be hanging off the scarf.



Follow the yarn manufacturer's washing and care instructions. Always lay flat to dry to avoid overstretching of the scarf. This will ensure you have the perfect scarf to wear for years to come. Visit **woolmark.com/care** for more simple tips on washing and drying wool.
